

ORDINANCE NO. 389

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING CERTAIN TRUCK TRAFFIC ON THE PUBLIC STREETS OF THE CITY OF HOPE, KANSAS AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

Be it Ordained by the Governing Body of the City of Hope, Kansas, that:

Section 1. Operation of large trucks with trailers, semi-trailers, or combinations thereof, is hereby prohibited upon the public streets of the City of Hope, Kansas, except when necessary in serving premises adjacent to said address.

Section 2. Parking of all semi-tractors, large trucks shall be off street. Parking shall be allowed at residences but must be off street. No sidewalks or city rights of way shall be blocked.

Section 3. Appropriate signs shall be placed on all arterial streets leading into said City apprising travelers of the prohibition provided by this ordinance.

Section 4. Any person convicted of the violation shall be fined a sum of not less than \$15.00 and not exceeding \$100.00 for the first violation, and not exceeding \$200.00 for any subsequent violation.

Section 5. Any person who is in violation of this ordinance and does not promptly comply with request for removal by a law enforcement officer shall have the offending vehicle/trailer towed. The cost of towing shall be added to the fine and court costs set forth in Sec. 4.


Section 6. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
